

Joan Alberti Memorial Fine Art Scholarship

The Joan Alberti Memorial Fine Art Scholarship, established by Victoria (Alberti) Carlin, is a competitive scholarship for Suffolk County High School Graduating Seniors who are considering furthering their education in Fine Arts. Two scholarships of \$400 each will be awarded in 2010 to Suffolk County High School Graduating Seniors who show exceptional promise in fine art. Based on the evaluation of a submitted CD portfolio and essay, the Scholarship Committee will select two (2) award winners.

Applying for the Joan Alberti Memorial Fine Art Scholarship

Students who have had a strong interest in visual arts throughout high school and are considering studying fine arts in college are encouraged to apply for this award.

All materials must be received by Friday, April 16, 2010 (this is not a postmark deadline) and should include:

1. Eight to ten works that demonstrate the student's range of proficiencies and best document the depth and breadth of an applicant's potential in art. Required format: A portfolio of work in CD format. Please label medium and dimensions of all work.
2. A typed, double-spaced, one-page statement indicating the student's desire to pursue art and its relation to their future goals.
3. Completed Joan Alberti Memorial Fine Art Scholarship application form.

The portfolio should demonstrate a student's:

1. Ability to create art/design from a personal perspective that embodies a sense of creativity and an awareness of context
2. Awareness of the effective use of media, tools, and materials
3. Command of the formal elements of art within the appropriate contexts
4. Ability to establish personal criteria, set goals, and pursue independent creative production
5. Breadth and depth of technical skill in a specific discipline
6. Ability to present finished works of art/design appropriately for public review in a digital format.

The portfolio should be sent to the Joan Alberti Memorial Fine Art Scholarship, Huntington Arts Council, 213 Main Street, Huntington, NY 11743.

Submitted application materials including portfolio in CD format will be reviewed and rated by our Scholarship Committee. The Huntington Arts Council cannot accept actual artwork as part of the application process.

The student who applies for this scholarship should have a serious intention to consider a major in the area of fine art; however, application for this scholarship is not a binding commitment to become an art major if a student determines later that another major is more suitable.
